

Guest & Employee Safety Measures

Guest Safety

Privacy

- Sinegal Estate Winery is by appointment only.
- The entrance to Sinegal Estate is gated.
- Upon arrival, guests are granted access and greeted by their dedicated Wine Ambassador--their single guide during the entire hospitality experience.
- Each party/guest does not cross paths with other guests outside of their party.
- The cadence of the Sinegal hospitality experience is designed for complete and maximum privacy enjoyment.
- There are no communal hospitality experiences. Each party is hosted in a private venue at the Estate.
- The visitation schedule affords ample time to disinfect all hospitality areas between appointments.

Safety

- Wine Ambassadors always remain at least 6 feet from guests, and wear PPE coverings – masks and gloves.
- PPE coverings including masks and gloves are offered to guests upon arrival to the winery.
- Weather permitting, many of the hospitality experiences occur outdoors.
- Hand sanitizer is provided to guests upon entry.
- Hand sanitizer is provided at multiple locations through the property.
- All surfaces, doorknobs, tables, chairs, restrooms, etc. are sanitized and cleaned hourly.
- Promotional materials provided to guests are not reused.
- When pouring wine, wine bottle “necks” don’t touch the guest’s glass.
- Wines are poured upon guest arrival prior to the seating of the guests.
- All glassware is always sterilized at 180°F in the commercial glasswasher.
- CDC guidance on proper handwashing practices is posted in restrooms.
- Waste receptacles are available for the disposal of one-time use materials.
- “Contactless” payment methods are used to the extent possible.
- Entrance doors to tasting areas are propped open at all times.
- Close proximity to guests is minimized to the extent feasible when pouring wines, receiving payment.
- Wine purchases are carried to the guest’s vehicle for placement in the trunk by the dedicated Wine Ambassador.

Employee Health and Personal Hygiene

- Employees maintain robust personal hygiene protocols as outlined by the Centers for Disease Control, and wash their hands upon arrival at work and routinely throughout the day.
- Employees regularly self-monitor for symptoms and take their own temperature each day before traveling to work.
- Any employees with a temperature reading of 100 degrees or higher, or that exhibits any other COVID-19 related symptoms (cough, sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea) will refrain from going to work.
- Employees should be without fever for 24 hours (after finishing fever-reducing medicines) before returning to work.
- Employees will wear face coverings when interacting with others from the recommended physical distance and during meetings.
- Employees will notify their supervisor if they begin to feel sick.
