THE INAUGURAL VINTAGE OF 2022 SINEGAL ESTATE SONOMA COUNTY CABERNET SAUVIGNON OPENS WITH FOCUSED AROMAS OF DARK CHERRY, PLUM, AND SUBTLE BAKING SPICES, FRAMED BY A TOUCH OF VANILLA AND TOASTED OAK. ON THE PALATE, IT OFFERS A CONCENTRATED CORE OF RIPE FRUIT, BALANCED BY FINE-GRAINED TANNINS AND A FRESH, LIFTED ACIDITY. NOTES OF CLOVE, CEDAR, AND COCOA EMERGE GRACEFULLY, ADDING DEPTH WITHOUT OVERPOWERING THE FRUIT. THE ROCKY, VOLCANIC SOILS LEND A DISTINCT MINERAL EDGE, CONTRIBUTING TO THE WINE'S STRUCTURE AND REFINEMENT. THE FINISH IS LONG AND WELL-INTEGRATED, SHOWCASING BOTH ELEGANCE AND PRECISION.
