### Tasting Notes

The 2022 DETAILS Cabernet Sauvignon offers expressive aromas of ripe red fruit and baking spice. Heat spikes during the season amplified flavor and depth, yielding a rich, full-bodied wine with plush tannins and refined acidity. Volcanic hillside soils add structure and complexity, while the long, layered finish highlights the wine's bold yet balanced character.

### Vintage Notes

The 2022 vintage began with ideal spring and summer weather before early September heat spikes and late rains split the harvest. Drought and extreme conditions reduced yields but produced intensely concentrated, structured reds, while the moderate early season yielded fresh, elegant whites and rosés—a challenging year that delivered exceptional quality.
